Prior to commencing with any commercial photography within Airport Property, the following must be read and filled out:

Definitions

For this purpose, the "Airport Property" of Santa Barbara can be defined as all commercial and non-commercial areas of the airport including the Airline Terminal, Fixed Base Operators, all businesses holding lease or permit agreements with the City of Santa Barbara Airport Administration, all undeveloped lands within Airport Property boundaries, observation areas, and all wetlands incorporated in the Airport Property boundaries.

Regulations

- 1) Insurance: permittee shall furnish proof of general liability insurance of not less than \$1 million combined single limit coverage, naming the City of Santa Barbara as additional insured.
- 2) Permittee shall abide by all rules and regulations of the airport and the City of Santa Barbara and shall not interfere with any other business or entity permitted to conduct business on Airport Property.
- 3) Applicant shall first gain permission for photography from the Airport Director. The Airport Director has final say as to the suitability of any activity.
- 4) The fee for filming on Airport Property is \$1,000 per day. All fees are due before activity commences. The total number of vehicles and persons that are, at any one time, in the area of photography will be determined by the Airport Director on an individual basis. Vehicles are subject to regular parking fees in all parking lots.
